- 2. Speed Tables on Park Street and Church Way

The council discussed the quotes for speed tables on Park Street and Church Way. The quotes were Allied Paving \$65,000, A&S Paving \$40,846, Traffic Logix \$60,050, and East Coast Grading \$65,000. Council member Stephanie Moncrief made motion to approve A&S paving bid. Council member Mary Hall second. Passed unanimous.

3. 1121 Park Street

a: Fencing

The council reviewed quotes for the fencing of 1121 Park Street. The quotes were Alcovy Fence \$15,484.11, Martin Robins \$18,678, Roberts Fence \$18,890, and Universal Fence \$27,200. There was discussion of updated pricing due to rising material cost and also discussion about the barb wire on the fence. Council member made a motion to approve with a 10% +/- price difference due to material cost. Council member Stephanie Moncrief second. Passed unanimous.

b: Heating and Air Unit

The council discussed quotes received for installation of HVAC for 1121 Park Street. The quotes were JH Martin \$6000 and \$7000 for different equipment, and Duren Mechanical for \$5995. There was discussion of whether the quotes came with a warranty on labor. Council member Jon Dial made motion to approve the JH Martin quote contingent on parts and labor warranties. Council member Linda Pilgrim second. Passed unanimous.
